Kendall Trail

This short (out and back - 3 miles round trip) trail runs along the Youghiogheny River upstream from Friendsville, MD. It follows an 1890s era railbed to an old logging community called Kendall (originally Krug). Little remains of the town of Kendall (on the opposite side of the river from the trail). Beyond Kendall (Landmark is a huge rock beside the river with steel sticking out) the trail continues but gets more and more rugged and eventually ends at National Falls about 2.5 miles beyond Kendall.
